There are plenty of sports and social amenities as well. You can keep active with an ultramodern gym, all-weather sports pitches and courts, and a six-lane swimming pool. 






See a show at Webster's Theatre, housed in the beautiful, gothic Lansdowne Parish Church.



Take a pathway course







3. ACCEPT YOUR OFFER


